

Steps to Access Your HESI A2 Score Report

You can retrieve your HESI A2 results from your Evolve account.

Step 1: Go to <https://evolve.elsevier.com/cs/store?role=student> to access your Evolve account.

Remediating nursing content improves outcomes

Lauer and Yoho (2013) found that HESI exit exam scores were higher for students attending programs which required remediation than exit scores for students in programs without required remediation.
